## **Performance Health, Inc./Biofreeze Humanitarian Award Presented to Dr. Nelson Goff at the ProSport Convention and Seminar in Las Vegas**

Performance Health recently awarded its humanitarian award in conjunction with the ProSport Convention and Seminar to Dr. Nelson Goff, Yucca Valley California. Dr Goff has been an active member of The ProSport organization since 1993 in addition to maintaining an active practice for 20 years.

In presenting the award Dr. Dana Mackison, Director of Education for Performance Health/Biofreeze recognized Dr. Goff for his volunteer efforts during the annual awards luncheon for the ProSport organization held in Las Vegas on December 2, 2005.

Dr. Goff began providing support to The Salvation Army in his area in 1988 through a program that was called "Help Other People Eat". In a continuation of this program Dr. Goff's office has continued to provide care in exchange for food donated to his office at least 2 times per year. This has allowed the Salvation Army through Dr. Goff's efforts, in collecting over 2000 pounds of food with each event, to feed from 600 to 900 individuals in the area.

In 2005 Dr. Goff's office also took on another effort for the Salvation Army when they raised \$3904 for the Katrina effort in one day with a suggested gift of \$10.00 for each patient who received an adjustment.

The Biofreeze Humanitarian award was established to recognize an individual whom not only devoted years in service to his patients but also provides untiring support in volunteer efforts within their community. In addition to the special recognition for Dr. Goff, Performance Health made a \$500 donation in the name of Dr. Goff to his favorite charity, The Salvation Army.
